ENTRIES CLOSE Wednesday 25th May 2019

Late entries may be accepted if there is space,

there will be a £5 per entry late payment fee for entries received after the closing date

All classes will be suitable for first timers at these levels with “L” alternatives where appropriate on the XC course. However, we will be running under PC rules with regard to elimination for multiple refusals ie. 3 at one fence or 4 around the course – NO EXCEPTIONS.

The Show Jumping and Cross Country courses will be ready to walk between 2pm and 6pm on Saturday 8th June. If you choose to walk the course before 2pm on 8th June, please be aware that changes may be made, it is your responsibility to check that you are jumping the correct course before you compete!

CLASS 1 – 60 - 65cm Pony club teams and individuals.

Rosettes sponsored by Downlands Estate

Teams to be made up of 3 or 4 Pony Club members aged 12 years or under on day of the competition.

Members aged over 12 may enter this class as individuals only, providing the combination of pony and rider have not been placed 1st to 3rd in any jumping/eventing competition at 75cm or higher. Please respect the spirit of this rule!

Dressage: Pony Club Introduction to dressage (2019). *The dressage test may be commanded in this class ONLY*

Show Jumping: max 0.65m. Cross Country: max 0.60m Riders eliminated in the SJ may go XC only at the discretion of the show jumping judge/organiser. Their decision is FINAL.

Please note that this class does go into the back field and into the water – riders must be off the lead and be in control in open spaces.

CLASS 2 – 75-80cm Pony club teams and individuals.

Rosettes sponsored by Liphook Equine Hospital

Open to all Pony Club members. Combination of pony and rider not to have competed at PC90 Area or above or been placed 1st to 3rd in any jumping competition at 90cm or higher

Dressage: Pony Club Grassroots Dressage (2018).

Show Jumping: max 0.80m. Cross Country: max 0.75m Riders eliminated in the SJ may go XC only at the discretion of the show jumping judge/organiser. Their decision is FINAL.

CLASS 3 – PC90 Pony club teams and individuals.

Rosettes sponsored by Rifleoak Ltd

Open to all Pony Club members

Dressage: PC90 Eventing Test (2013).

Show Jumping: max 0.95m. Cross Country: max 0.90m

Riders eliminated in the SJ phase may NOT go XC (if it is a technical elimination ONLY they may do so at the discretion of the judge/organiser)

FIRST AID cover is included in the Entry Fee of £51 per class

Teams: riders MUST be entered online – paper entry forms can be scanned and sent to chiddingfold.entries@gmail.com by the team manager/organiser.

Riders may ride a maximum of 2 ponies. No pony may be competed more than once.

When collecting your number please bring:

- **a £10 cash bib deposit, this will be returned to you when you bring back your number bib after you have competed.**
- **Your HAT – correctly tagged and conforming to the Pony Club 2019 rules.**
- **Your Body Protector that conforms to the Pony Club 2019 rules.**

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please refer to the main Pony Club website for full Pony Club Eventing 2019 Rule Book.

Entries are only accepted on the basis of all these Rules and Conditions.

LEGAL LIABILITY : Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of the event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord, his tenant(s) or his licensee accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE : Organisers of Eventing Competitions take reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.

- 1) **INSURANCE**: All non Pony Club competitors/spectators are **not** covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The organising Branch and the committee of this event are not legally responsible for non-Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 2) All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
- 3) **This competition will be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rules 2019**, which will apply to all disciplines throughout the day. It is the responsibility of all competitors to know the rules.
- 4) **Cancellation Policy**: In the event of **cancellation**, £5 of each individual entry fee will be retained to defray expenses. If this event is cancelled, Team Organisers should send an SAE to the Entries Secretary. In the case of **abandonment** no refunds will be given except at the discretion of the organising committee.
- 5) **Withdrawals**:
 - withdrawals can be made without forfeit of entry fee up to the close of entries on Wednesday 22nd May
 - withdrawals made after 25th May will only be refunded with the presentation of a vet or doctor's certificate, less £5 administration fee
 - Entries received after 25th May will incur a £5 late entry fee
 - there will be NO refund of entry fee after the publication of times
 - a rider may substitute a horse as long as it is in the same class
 - a rider cannot be moved from one class to another after the close of entries.

For team entries:

- details of all team members and ponies must be received by close of entries
 - Team changes, where possible, should be made before the close of entries. These should be emailed directly to the entries secretary.
 - once times have been published we will not make cosmetic changes to teams. We will move an individual into a team to replace a withdrawal but we will not move riders between teams.
 - no changes to teams can be made on the day, only substitutions of individuals moving into a team to fill a gap
- 6) **THE JUDGES' DECISION is final** in all cases.
 - 7) **PROTESTS OR OBJECTIONS** : Any query about a competitor's score must be made only at the Secretary's Office. No approach may be made to the Judge, Time Keeper, Fence Judge or Official concerned. Protests or objections must be made in writing and addressed to the Official Steward. Only District Commissioners or their Appointed Representatives are entitled to lodge a

- protest or objection. Protests must be accompanied by a deposit of £25, which is forfeit unless the Official Steward/Organiser, decides that there were good and reasonable grounds for it. Protests or objections must be made not later than half an hour after the incident that gave rise to them, or half an hour after the scores have been published. Objections to Dressage scores must be made not later than 1/2 hour after the scoresheets have been released.
- 8) **Hats:** All competitors must wear a protective helmet manufactured to the minimum standards stated in the current Pony Club 2019 rules. When mounted the chinstrap must be fastened at all times.
 - 9) **Hats & Body Protectors** will be inspected when collecting numbers (£10 returnable deposit required for number bib).
 - 10) **Jewellery** - No jewellery is allowed for safety reasons, other than medical jewellery, a wristwatch, a wedding ring, a stock pin worn horizontally or a tie clip. It is recommended that stock pins are removed for cross country. Members who are contemplating piercing their ears or any other part of their body should be aware that they will not be allowed to compete until such a time as the "sleepers" can safely be removed. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**
 - 11) Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horseboxes. Please park where instructed by the stewards. No horses may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
 - 12) No lungeing in the lorry park or show jump/XC warm up areas.
 - 13) There will be a **compulsory tack check**, which will take place before **every** phase of the competition, please allow extra time for this when going to warm up.
 - 14) **SPURS** - Please see 2019 Rule Book for full details of accepted spurs. Any misuse of spurs, whip or bit will incur elimination.
 - 15) **VACCINATION CERTIFICATES & PASSPORTS:** All horses must have up to date vaccinations against equine influenza. Vaccination certificates and passports should be carried with the horse/pony to all competitions and must be available for inspection if asked by an event official.
 - 16) **In view of recent accidents, horses and ponies tied up to the outside of horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended under any circumstances.**
 - 17) Please ensure that the area around your horsebox or trailer is left clean and tidy and in particular that all droppings, hay and rubbish are cleared up and taken home with you.
 - 18) **Dogs are NOT allowed at Fair-Oak at any time under any circumstances.**
 - 19) Rude or Offensive language or behaviour will not be tolerated and will incur elimination.
 - 20) Entries will be limited and **will not** be accepted by telephone or email or until full payment is received. The organisers reserve the right to run the classes in any order to suit the entries received.
 - 21) Class 3 competitors eliminated in the show jumping will **not** be allowed to go cross country (possible exception for a technical elimination). In class 1 and 2 it will be at the discretion of the judges. Too fast time penalties can be incurred in Classes 1 and 2 but not for going too slowly. **In Class 3, time penalties will be awarded for going too fast or too slow. We would remind you that at Rogate, the hill in the back field and the fact that going into, through and out of the woods slows riders down, means that riders often incur time faults on this course that they might not over courses elsewhere.**
 - 22) By entering you agree to your name, pony's name, branch etc. being published online for the purposes of distributing the competition times and results.
