ADDITIONAL TRI AND TET INFORMATION:

- Age: On 1st January 2019. Must be 8+ on the day to compete in shooting
- **MIXED GENDER TEAMS:** Teams in each age group to consist of three or four boys and/or girls from the same P.C Branch, best three scores to count. **Teams can be all boys, all girls or any mixture.**
- RIDING: Competitors may opt to jump a lower course in classes 4b and 3b and incur a 400 point penalty. No horse/pony may go round the course more than twice.
- SHOOTING: Guns to be cased at all times until instructed by the shoot steward. Guns to be carried by ADULTS and loaders to be over 18yrs old.
- SWIMMING: Competitors to be able to swim 25 metres. Swim hats to be worn. Flotation aids allowed in Class 1 only. No muddy shoes by the pool.
- Please be advised that if you enter a Tetrathlon class you cannot enter an ODE Class.

RULES and CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please Read This Page Carefully

LEGAL LIABILITY: Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant(s), accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. **Entries are only accepted on this basis.**

HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE: The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

1. **INSURANCE:** Please be aware that all non-Pony Club competitors/spectators are **not** covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Hampshire Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
2. All persons entering the showground shall be bound by these Rules and Conditions of Entry.
3. This event will be run under Pony Club Eventing, Show Jumping and Dressage Rules 2019 throughout the day. Please note rulings on hats, body protectors and air jackets. Fully comprehensive rules are available on the main Pony Club website. It is the responsibility of competitors to know and comply with the rules.
4. **PC Tetrathlon: XC classes will be run in accordance with the 2019 P.C. Tetrathlon rulebook**
http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/tetrathlon/Tetrathlon_Rules_for_web.pdf.
5. **Cancellation/Abandonment:** In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be returned, less an administration fee of £5.00 per competitor, to offset costs. Monies will only be returned upon receipt of an SAE within 5 days of the event. In the case of abandonment no refunds will be given except at the discretion of the organizing committee.
6. **Withdrawals & Refunds:** No entry will be refunded after the entry closing date of Wednesday 4th September 2019, without the production of a Doctor's or Vet's certificate within 3 days of the event, subject to notification of withdrawal prior to the event.
7. **Late Entries:** Will be accepted at an extra £10 after midday on the closing date.
8. **Team Entries:** Details of Team entries must be received by close of entries. Any team changes before this date should be emailed directly to the entries secretary. No team changes can be made on the day.
9. The judges' decision is final in all matters. Video evidence will not be accepted in any circumstances. The committee reserves the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the conditions or competitions as they think fit and to refuse entry at their discretion.
10. **Protests or objections:** Must be made in writing and addressed to the Official Steward accompanied by a £20 deposit, returnable if the objection is upheld, within 30 minutes of the incident occurring or within 30 minutes of the results being announced.
11. **Hats:** All competitors must wear a protective helmet manufactured to the minimum standards stated in the current Pony Club rules. When mounted the chinstrap must be fastened at all times.
12. **Hats & Body Protectors** will be inspected when collecting numbers (£10 returnable deposit).
13. **Jewellery** – No jewellery is allowed for safety reasons, other than medical jewellery, a wristwatch, a wedding ring, a stock pin worn horizontally or a tie clip. It is recommended that stock pins are removed for cross country.
14. **Spurs** – Please see 2019 PC Rule Book for full details of accepted spurs. Any misuse of spurs, whip or bit will incur elimination.
15. **Vaccination Certificates & Passports:** All horses and ponies must have up to date vaccinations against equine influenza. Vaccination certificates and passports should be carried with the horse/pony to all competitions and events and must be available for inspection if asked by an event official. We would recommend a six month booster in line with the Pony Club and BEF guidelines.
16. In view of recent accidents, horses and ponies tied up to the outside of horseboxes or trailers must not be left unattended under any circumstances.
17. Horses/ponies must not be exercised near horseboxes. No horses may be ridden other than by the competitor on the day of the competition.
18. No lungeing in the lorry park or show jump/XC warm up areas.
19. Please park where instructed by the stewards.
20. Horses and ponies must be over 4 years old on the day of the competition.
21. Please do not muck out lorries/trailers into the parking area, and do not leave any litter. Please remove droppings and hay.

Entries - Early entry is recommended as entries will be strictly limited.
Entries will not be accepted by telephone or email or until full payment is received.
Please note that if you enter an ODE class you cannot enter a Tetrathlon class.

All boxes and trailers must turn left when leaving the show ground. There is a one way system for all users of Fair Oak, all horse boxes and trailers must AT ALL TIMES turn left when leaving and travel via South Harting. We have been asked by the Parish Council to remind all drivers that there is a 6'6" width restriction for the road into Rogate from the North (Rake Direction) and no horse boxes are allowed to use this road and if they come into Rogate it must be on the main road A272 before turning south towards Fair Oak.
