### Class 2: PC70

Restricted - combination not to have been placed in a 80cms or higher ODE

**Dressage Test:** PC Introduction to Dressage Test 2019

**Show jumping:** max 75cms

**Cross Country:** max 70cms

**Entry Fee: £50.00 including admin fee**

### Class 3: PC60

**Dressage Test:** C Level Dressage Test

**Show jumping:** max 65cms **Cross Country:** max 60cms

**Entry Fee: £50.00 including admin fee**

### Class 4: PC50

**Dressage Test:** Walk & Trot 2013

**Show jumping:** max 55cms **Cross Country:** max 50cms

## **RULES AND CONDITIONS**

**Because of the ever-changing COVID restrictions, final instructions will be issued with times.**

**It is the rider's responsibility to be in the right place at the right time.**

- Please be aware of current Government restrictions, which may alter after these rules were written.
- Each phase will have a limit on the number of riders allowed in the designated warm-up arenas at any one time. This information will be made available to you at the entrance to the warm-up arena and the numbers will be controlled dependent upon current regulations and space available. You **MUST NOT RIDE IN ANY OTHER AREAS.**
- **PRIZE GIVING:** Arrangements to be confirmed on the day dependent on COVID regulations at that time. We will be running live scores throughout the day and these can be found on [www.ponyclubresults.co.uk](http://www.ponyclubresults.co.uk)
- **VACCINATIONS:** must be up to date with the annual vaccination. If your horse has missed the annual renewal then you will need to restart the course of injections again before competing.
- **LEGAL LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event nor the Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, or the landlord or landowner, his tenant(s), his contractors or his licensee accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- **HEALTH, SAFETY & WELFARE:** The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers.

The Hampshire Hunt and Cowdray Hunt branches of the Pony Club cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons, horses or property howsoever caused and it is a condition of entry that all rules will be accepted.

## RULES AND CONDITIONS CONT

1. No horse may be entered in more than one class and no stallions except with the permission of the HPCDC.
2. The event will be run under PONY CLUB EVENTING RULES 2021. It is your responsibility to familiarise yourself with these rules. They can be found on [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org). A copy of the Pony Club Eventing Rule Book 2020 will be available at the secretary's tent. Approved hats with chin straps done up must be worn when mounted at all times.
3. Entry fees refunded up to closing date, after closing date refunds will ONLY be given on production of doctor's or veterinary certificate. In the event of cancellation by the organisers, £10 will be retained to cover administration expenses.
4. The organisers reserve the right to stop and eliminate any competitor who is deemed to be dangerous and/or for excessive use of whip or spurs.
5. **The Judges' decision is final in all cases.** Objections are to be lodged with the Secretary, in writing, within 30 minutes, together with a deposit of £25.
6. In light of the changes, made by BE and with child safeguarding at the forefront of our minds we added the following rule:  
**If you fall off in the Dressage or Show Jumping you may remount and continue that phase (if able and happy to) but you must be seen, and signed off, by the Show Jumping ambulance crew before going to the next phase. If you fall off anywhere on the Cross Country you will be eliminated and must leave the course and please get checked by the ambulance crew before leaving. However, in all cases if the judge deems it unsafe for the competitor to continue to the next phase, their decision WILL BE FINAL.**
7. All competitors must report to their respective Stewards at least 15 minutes before their time to compete for a TACK CHECK. Tack has to be in accordance with the Pony Club Rules.
8. Back protectors are compulsory when on the cross-country course and should preferably be worn for showjumping. Medical armbands are recommended to be worn for the cross-country phase on the arm. If you have a Woof Wear body protector or any other key locked protector, a labelled key must be left with the Secretary BEFORE your number is given out and Paramedics informed. A normal body protector is required to be worn under any inflatable protector.
9. The Cross Country will be timed. Any competitor deemed to be going dangerously fast will be eliminated.
10. Warming up of horses in the Box/Trailer/Car Parks is strictly prohibited. Please use the areas provided.
11. Horses/ponies tied to the outside of trailers/lorries MUST NOT be left unattended.
12. Please leave your parking area clear of hay and droppings. ALL litter must be picked up and disposed of responsibly.

### **All boxes and trailers must turn left when leaving the show ground**

There is a one way system for all users of Fair Oak, all horse boxes and trailers must AT ALL TIMES turn left when leaving and travel via South Harting. We have been asked by the Parish Council to remind all drivers that there is a 6'6" width restriction for the road into Rogate from the North (Rake Direction) and no horse boxes are allowed to use this road and if they come into Rogate it must be on the main road A272 before turning south towards Fair Oak.
